DAILY CONTACT WITH SENIORS AND THE HOME BOUND

Contacting an elderly person, home bound individual or latch-key child on a daily basis helps to reassure their well being and give them a feeling of security. The R U OK? telephone reassurance program eases the concern of friends and family who may find it difficult to maintain consistent, reliable contact. Each day at a pre-arranged time, the system automatically makes computerized monitoring calls cost-effectively and without interruption to normal public safety services. If the subscriber does not answer after a preset number of call attempts, an alert is given to a police officer to conduct a welfare check. The Brownsburg Police Department is proud to offer this service free of charge in support of community service-oriented policing and in the spirit of the general health and well-being of Town of Brownsburg citizens.
